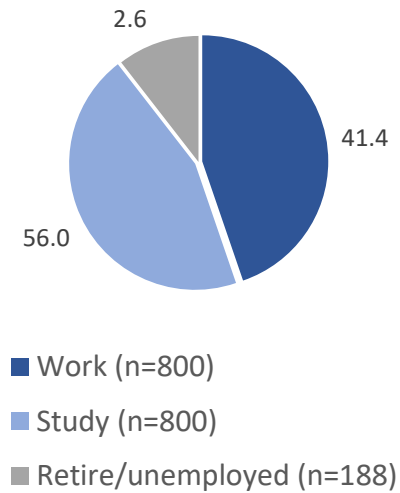

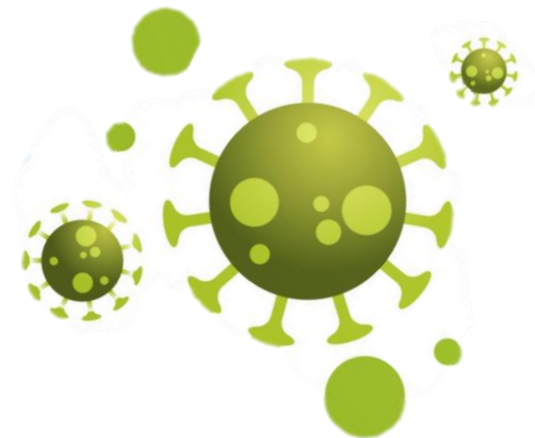
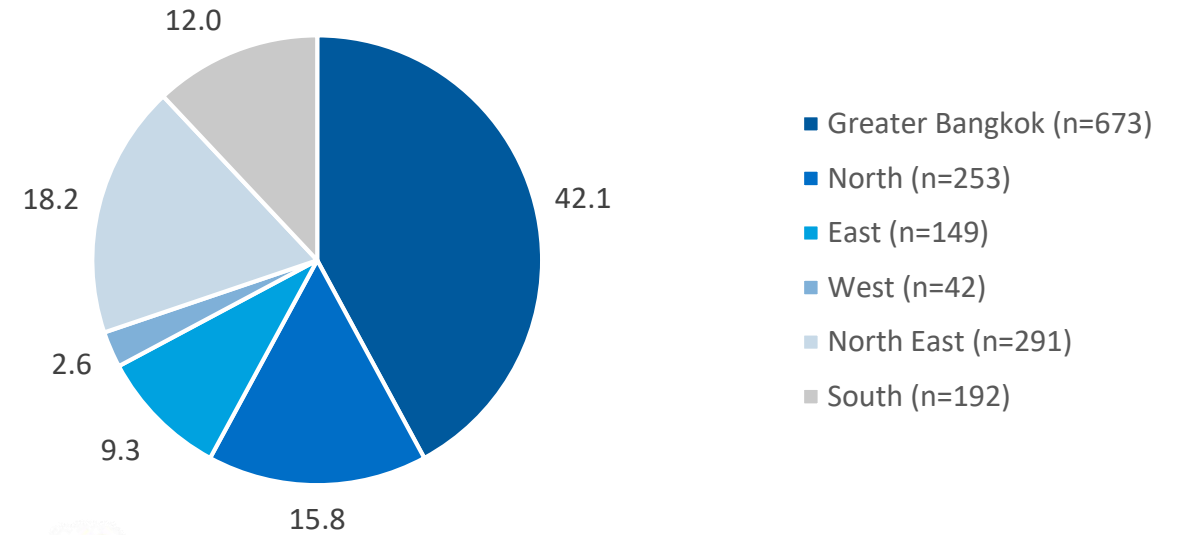

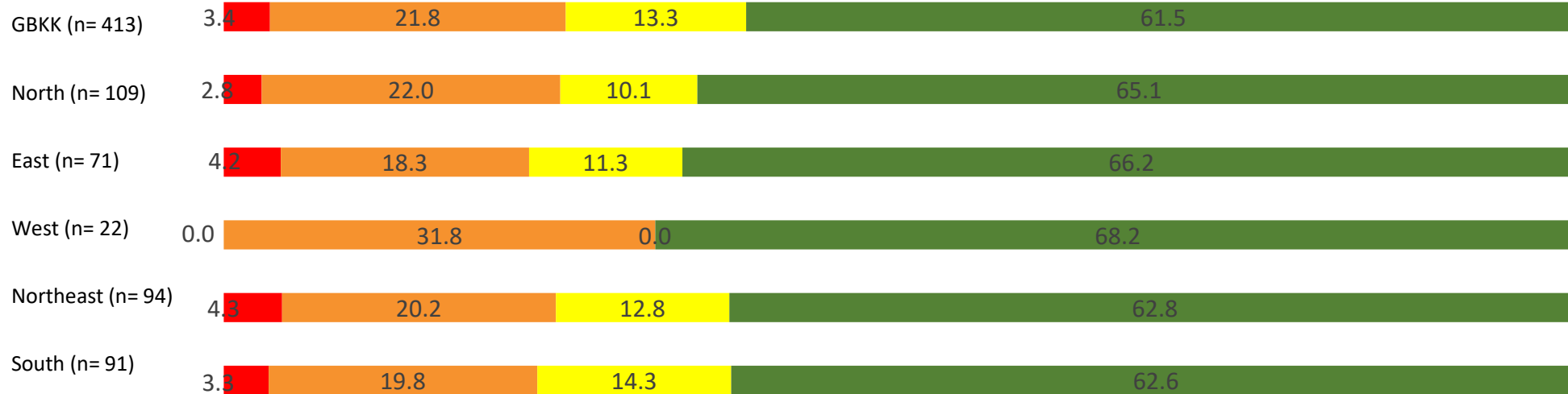


Situation amid COVID-19 spread

- Generally, Thai workers are working normally (62.9%)
 - Most of Thai workers are still working as usual (62.9%), however, unpaid leave showed a significant number (21.4%)



- Generally, Thai workers more than 60% are working. Unpaid leave seems to be trending

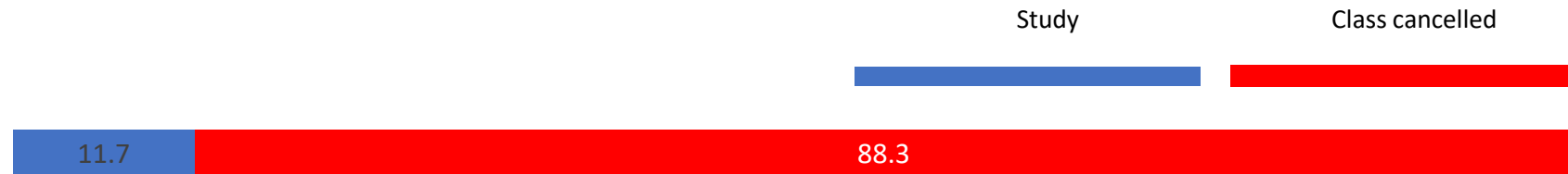

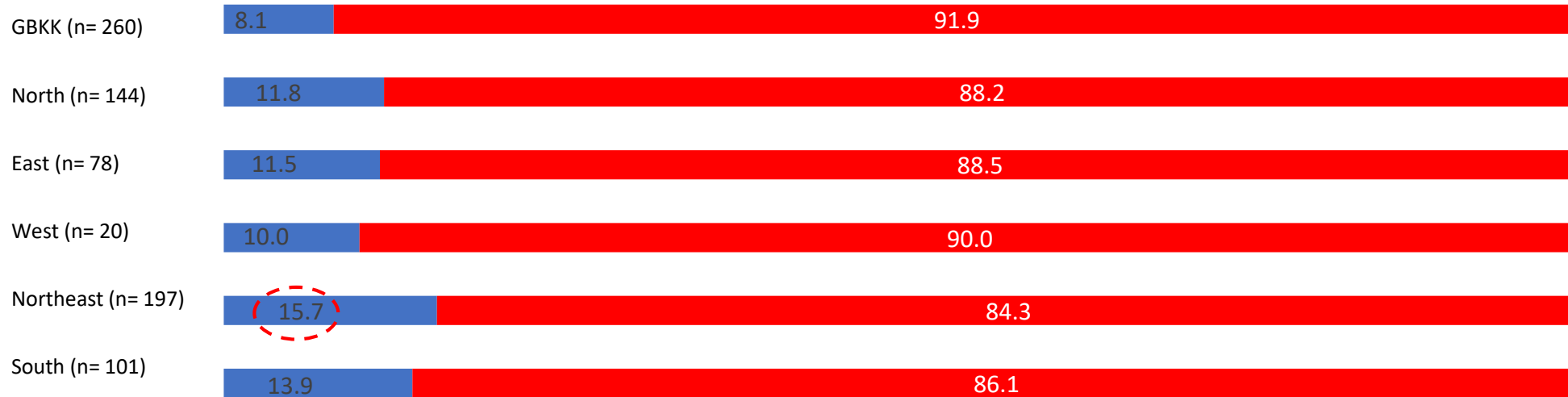

- Most of the classes were cancelled during this time (88.3%)
 - Most of the student are not going to school (88.3%), while only a few are still studying (11.7%)



- Surprisingly, Northeast has the highest class opening rate than any other parts of Thailand (15.7%)

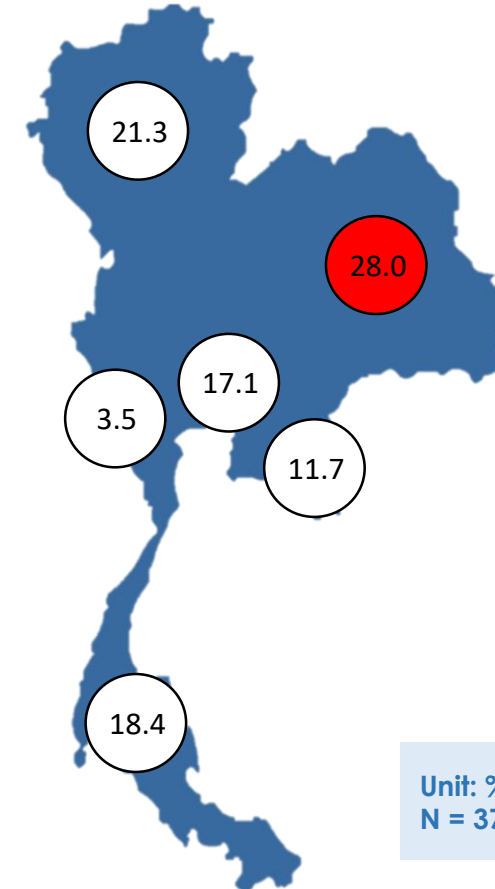

Situation amid COVID-19 spread

- Most of Thai do not going back to hometown during virus spread (79.0%)
 - Majority of Thai do not travelling back to their hometown during this period (79.0%)
 - Northeastern is the biggest destination for travelling back to hometown(28.1%), followed by Northern area (21.3%)

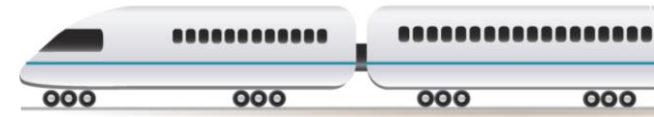
